3. Wittman Farms letter and response

- a. [Letter to Wittman Farms](#)
 - i. The board sent a letter to Wittman Farms expressing support for private property rights and our interest in cooperating with Wittman farms in reducing any tension between the house on Webb Ridge and Cyclists.

- b. [Letter from Peter Witman](#)

- i. We received a response from Peter Wittman, a partner in Wittman Farms, apologizing for the Huffy and Cross incident of a year ago and explaining the Farms point of view. The letter allowed appropriate cyclist use of the gravel patch beyond the driveway toward Lapwai. It expressly offered shelter from rain in the machine shed across the road and expressly denied permission to sit on the grass outside the fence on the house side.
- ii. We will send a letter acknowledging receipt and expressing cooperation. The Board wants a letter responding to Peter saying we appreciate the response and that we are in agreement and stay in touch if issues arise and reiterate Adventure Cycling route has people from all over the world.
- iii. The board asked that the letters themselves not be posted but do put the word out to cyclists that private property rights need to be respected at Webb Ridge.
